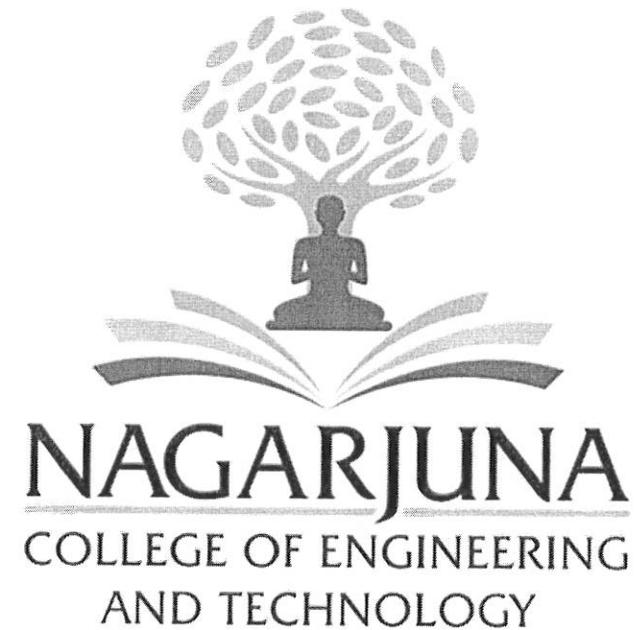

Section 1 : Items for Confirmation

4.	Suggested to introduce the Industry internship programme for the faculty members	The modalities of deputing the faculty members for Industry Internship programmes are being planned. However, the faculty members are encouraged to visit the industries.
5.	Suggested to enhance the research facilities in the institution	Measures are taken to improve the research facilities in the institution. High End Servers are procured for research activities in the AI/ML, Computer Science and Electronics departments.
