Chairman, then directed the Member Secretary to start the proceedings of the meeting with the agenda points. Member Secretary with the permission of the chair started the proceedings.

AGENDA & DISCUSSIONS:

Section 1 : Items for Confirmation

14/01 Confirmation of the proceedings of the 13th Meeting of Academic Council held on 31.08.2024

Member Secretary, placed the minutes of the 13th meeting of the Academic Council held on 31st August 2024 before the Academic Council and requested for the confirmation of the minutes. As there are no matter arising, the council permitted to confirm the minutes of 13th Meeting of Academic Council.

The Academic Council confirmed the Minutes of the 13th Meeting.

14/02 To Note the Action Taken Report on the suggestions/recommendations of the 13th Meeting of Academic Council held on 31.08.2024

Member Secretary placed before the council, the action taken report on the decisions/resolutions given in the 13th meeting of the AC held on 31st August 2024.

Section 2: Items for Information

14/03 To note the achievements of faculty and students

Member Secretary presented the achievements at the institutional level, faculty members and students after the 13th ACM before the Academic Council.

The Academic Council noted the same and appreciated the efforts of the institution, faculty Members and Students for their achievements.

14/04 To note the result analysis of Odd Semester of the AY 2024-25

Member Secretary presented the result analysis of the Odd Semester of the academic year 2024-25. The council noted that for few courses, the results are less than 50%. Dr. A P Partha informed the HODs to take suitable measures to improve the results in some of the courses. Mr. Mohan Kumar, informed the council that students having backlogs are not being considered for placement drives and hence suitable measures are to be taken to reduce the number of backlogs carried by the students from 5th semester onwards.

The matter is placed before the members of Council and the Council noted the same.

Section 3: Items for Ratification / Approval

14/05 Ratification / Approval of Recommendations of various Boards of Studies

The Member Secretary informed the Academic Council (AC) members that the meetings of the Board of Studies (BoS) of various departments had been conducted. The Member Secretary requested approval for the proposed changes and suggestions in the curriculum as discussed during the respective BoS meetings. The Member Secretary further requested the Chairmen of the Boards of Studies to present the recommendations of their respective Boards for ratification.

The Chairmen of the Boards of Studies of the following departments presented their recommendations for ratification.

- a. Computer Science and Engineering
- b. Information Science and Engineering
- c. Computer Science and Engineering (AIML)
- d. Computer Science and Engineering (Data Science)
- e. Electronics and Communication Engineering
- f. Civil Engineering
- g. MBA

The Academic Council ratified the changes recommended by the Board of Studies of the above departments.

14/06 Approval of changes in the Autonomous regulations

Members Secretary informed the council that VTU has released the guidelines for the Autonomous Regulations applicable from the AY 2024-25. Following changes are suggested as per the guidelines.

- Summer Term/Supplementary Semester re-introduced
- No Summer Term for PG Courses
- Summer Term- Maximum 14 credits for registration

- DX Grade instead of NE introduced
- Backlog Course can be taken along with Odd or Even Semesters
- Questions papers shall contain Higher Order Bloom's Level
- M.Tech Courses shall have general nomenclatures and specialization shall be mentioned in brackets.

The Academic Council approved changes in the autonomous regulations and decided to follow the VTU guidelines in letter and spirit.

14/07 Any other matter with the permission of the Chair

a. Approval to display the CIE and SEE Marks in the result sheet

Member Secretary informed the council that institution is receiving requests from the students with respect to the display of marks in the result sheet along with the grades and requested the members for permission to display the marks in the result sheet in addition to the grades. He further informed the council that answer book seeing facility for the failed courses is introduced from the current semester.

The Academic Council approved to display the CIE and SEE Marks in the result sheet and appreciated for the answer book seeing facility introduced by the examination section.

b. Approval of list of students graduating in Post Graduate Courses.

Controller of Examination informed the council that 117 students of MBA Programme have completed the requirements and are eligible to receive their degrees. The names of such students are forwarded to the university for the issue of the degree certificates during the convocation. Accordingly, the University has released the degree certificates and a Graduation Ceremony will be held on 05.04.2025 to award the degree certificates. Controller of Examinations requested the council to ratify the list of graduating students and further invited the members of the council to the Graduation Day.

The Academic Council ratified the list of graduating students and noted the date of Graduation Day for the award of degree certificates to the PG students.

As there were no other matter to discuss, Chairman expressed his happiness about the active involvement of all the members during the deliberations of the meeting and thanked all the members. He also sought the general comments from the external members about the proceedings of the meeting.

General Suggestions/ Comments given by the Academic Council Members:

- i. Dr. A P Partha and Dr. Dinesha Rangappa, VTU nominees expressed their happiness about the proceedings of the meeting and appreciated progress of the college. Dr A P Partha informed the council to take suitable measures to improve the results by introducing effective teaching learning methodologies.
- ii. Dr. Dinesh Rangappa suggested to reduce the duration of the induction programme for 3rd semester students to a week instead of two weeks.
- iii. Dr. Krishnamurthy G N, appreciated the scheme of Seed money being offered by the institution for research activities and the research promotion policy of the institution. He further suggested

to arrange for expert lectures/awareness programmes on new NBA format for tier-1 institutions.

- iv. Mr. Vivek E Ashokkumar suggested to include more practical orientation and making use of social media platforms for branding and promoting innovative curriculum content.
- v. Mr. Mohan Kumar suggested to include provide training on soft skills, sustainability and DevSecOps course in addition to DevOps Course.



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


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Result Analysis for the Odd Semester 2024-25


First Semester BE 2024-25
