Objectives:

- Recruit young individuals to build a youthful, dynamic force with enhanced risktaking ability, as per Indian Air Force vision.
- Introduce new skills and modernize the workforce.
- Attract individuals with the potential to embrace and utilize technology.
- Offer a short-term service opportunity through the Agnipath Scheme.
- Foster national service and discipline among youth through limited-period armed forces service.

The Agniveer Vayu Recruitment is part of the Agnipath Scheme, launched by the Government of India, aiming to induct young Indian citizens into the Indian Air Force (IAF) for a short tenure of four years. This opportunity is open to unmarried Indian male and female candidates.

For Intake 01/2026, applications were accepted from January 7 to January 27, 2025, with the online examination scheduled to start from March 22, 2025. Eligible candidates must be born between January 1, 2005, and July 1, 2008, and should have passed 10+2 with a minimum of 50% marks from a recognized board



. Selection Process:

The recruitment consists of four key stages:

1. Online Test
2. Physical Fitness Test (PET)
3. Adaptability test -II
4. Medical Examination

Candidates must qualify each stage to proceed to the next. Only online applications are accepted via the official Indian Air Force website. Aspirants are advised to go through the official notification for detailed eligibility and guidelines.

- Understand the career paths in the IAF.
- Learn about eligibility criteria and selection stages.
- Ask questions directly to IAF personnel.
